Introduction

Pressure from poverty, traumatic experiences, violence, and illness can drive a family from their safe home onto the streets.

American Vincetians maintain a network of charity focused on housing.

In the spirit of St. Vincent de Paul and Blessed Fredric Ozanam, 30 conferences manage over 100 different special works projects to address the need for safe homes and housing.

Our collective impact on providing safe and affordable places for those in need is:

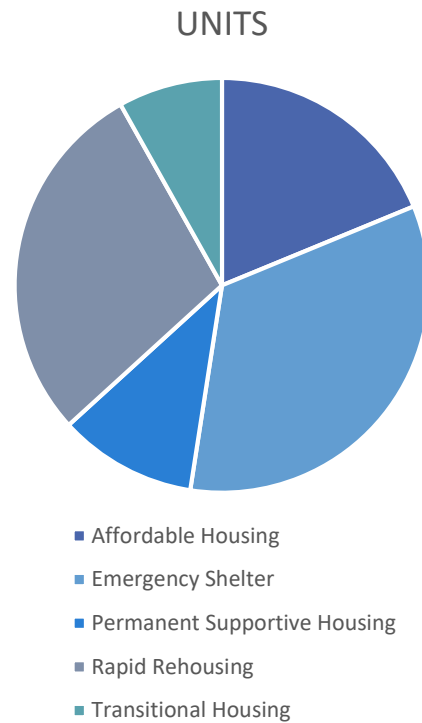

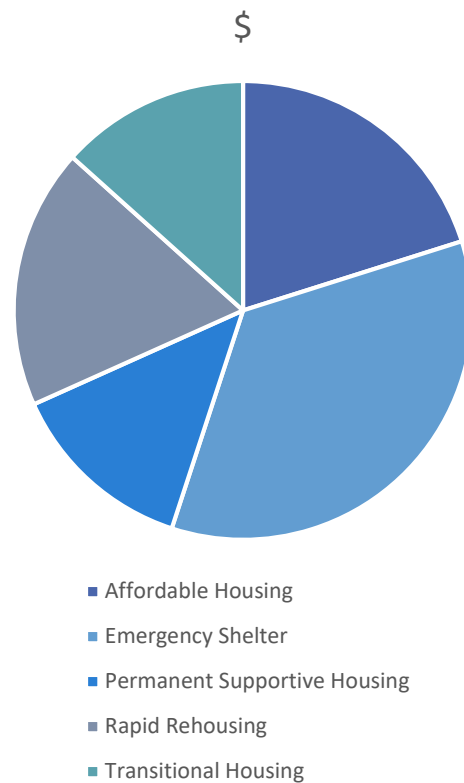

Emergency Shelters

Council partnerships within cities and churches meet the immediate need of those left in the cold. These emergency shelters provide a location for Vincentian case management to meet with those without a home. Many are “Housing First” shelters, where guests can connect with other services to support their long-term housing search.

Rapid Rehousing programs have proven to be the most effective and empowering way to *end* homelessness. Vincentian organizations continue to receive funding to help families locate, secure, and become stabilized in permanent housing.
